## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Public Place in Law Regulating Drinking in Public Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 61, § 96, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 96 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 'II. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall meansany hotel dining-room or restaurant not licensed for on-premise sale of liquor, common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or land, to which the public is invited or has access.'
