STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers and Duties of Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 8, sub-§ XVII, amended. The 4th sentence of subsection XVII of section 8 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 161 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

‘Their power and duties shall include the duty to inquire into and arrest for violations of any of the provisions of this chapter, and to arrest for impersonation of or interference with liquor inspectors, **and to arrest for disturbances of the peace in a liquor licensed premise or any public place as designated in section 96** and to serve all processes necessary for and pertaining to enforcement of any of the provisions of this chapter.’
