HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 900, L.D. 1234, Bill, "An Act
Regulating Lobster Traps on Trawls."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following title: 'An Act Relating
to Number of Lobster Traps on Trawls in Saco Bay, Cumberland
County.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R.S., c. 37-A, §74-B, additional. Chapter 37-A of the
Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the
public laws of 1959, is amended by adding a new section 74-B,
to read as follows:

'Sec. 74-B. Lobster traps on trawls in Saco Bay, Cumberland
County. It is unlawful to have on any trawl more than 3 lobster
traps on one warp and buoy in that part of Saco Bay west of a
line running 150° true from the center of Spurwink River in
Scarborough.'
