STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Reimburse Town of Warren for Cost of Municipal Services Provided for the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 1, § 21-A, additional. Chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 21-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 21-A. Warren reimbursed. The State of Maine shall pay annually to the Town of Warren the sum of \$7,500 for the municipal services rendered to the State by said town.'
