STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 1, amended. The 6th sentence of section 1 of chapter 20 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 5 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The Attorney General shall have an office in the State Capitol and shall receive an annual salary of \$10,000 \$12,000 in full for all services and in lieu of all fees.'

(There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this section.)

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
