# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Special Deputy Sheriffs in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 173, amended. Section 173 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 326 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 173. Special deputies in Cumberland County; compensation. The sheriff of Cumberland County shall may, subject to the approval of the county commissioners, appoint full-time deputy sheriffs, who shall serve at the pleasure of said sheriff and whose special duty shall be to enforce the criminal laws in said county and who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of \$11 per day and such additional pay as the county commissioners may approve, to be paid from the county treasury, together with such incidental expenses as may be necessary for the proper enforcement of said laws; bills for which shall be audited as provided in chapter 150, section 2.'
