STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Annual Permits to Move House Trailers and Mobile Homes Over Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 98, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 98 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The fee for such permits shall be not less than \$2, nor more than \$10, to be determined, on the basis of weight, height, length and width, by the State Highway Commission, except that any retail seller of house trailers or mobile homes upon proper written application and the payment of \$100 shall be granted an annual permit for the movement of such objects, the permit to be valid from January 1st to December 31st of the calendar year for which it was issued.'
