STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Short Term Permits for Certain Farm Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence of the 2nd paragraph a new sentence to read as follows:

'For any additional gross weight above 18,000 pounds, farm motor trucks registered under this section may receive a short term permit in accordance with this section by paying a percentage of the difference between the amount paid for the farm motor truck registration and the annual commercial truck fee for the desired tonnage in accordance with the permit table contained in this section. Farm trucks registered for more than 18,000 pounds gross weight shall not be used for the transportation of logs, lumber and pulpwood cut on a farm or farms owned, operated or occupied by the registrant unless the production thereof is incidental to other farm operations conducted by the registrant.'
