IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Sunday Hunting of Bobcat in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 76, amended. Section 76 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to the hunting of bobcat and Canada lynx during the months of January, February and March of each calendar year in Oxford County.'
