STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Milk Purchased by Dealer From Sources Other Than His Regular Producers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Any Maine market milk dealer who purchases, during a given period, milk from any source other than his regular producers must return to said producers at least 85% Class I utilization of all milk sold by them to said dealer for that given period.'
