AN ACT Relating to Disposition of Fines for Vehicle Overload Violators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 163, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 163 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 33 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'All fines and forfeitures collected under ~~the provisions of~~ this chapter shall accrue to the county where the offense is prosecuted, except that 80% of all fines and forfeitures collected for overload violations shall accrue to the General Highway Fund.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 163, amended. The last sentence of section 163 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 33 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed.
