STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Power Boats on Pennemaquan River, Tow of Pembroke.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 67, amended. Section 67 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 67. Restricting the use of power boats. No person shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by motor on that portion of Portage Lake in Townships T. 13, R. 6, W. E. L. S., County of Aroostook, known as the Floating Island Area, north and westerly of a line beginning at the eastern edge of the marshy peninsula running out from Hutchinson Ridge, running 50 yards outside of the floating islands in a northerly direction to the mouth of Mosquito Brook; and on that portion of Pennemaquan River in Pembroke, County of Washington, between the Little Falls Dam and the Iron Works Dam.'
