STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Levy on Property Upon Failure of Municipality to Pay Installment Due School Administrative District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 111-L, amended. The 3rd sentence from the end of section 111-L of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1-B of chapter 364 and repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'In the case of the failure of the treasurer of the said municipality to pay any installment or any part thereof on or before the dates set out above in the year in which the said tax is levied, the treasurer of the administrative district shall may issue his warrent for the amount of said tax or so much thereof as shall then remain unpaid to the county sheriff requiring him to levy by distress and sale on the real and personal property of any of the residents of said administrative district living in the municipality where such default takes place and the sheriff or any of his deputies shall execute said warrant, except as otherwise provided.'
