STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for a Two Year Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 11 of chapter 363 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'A fee of \$2 \$5 shall accompany the application.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 121 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed as follows:

'All renewal licenses to operate motor vehicles issued after December 31, 1958 shall expire annually at midnight on the anniversary of license holder's date of birth. The fee for such license shall be computed at the rate of 1/4 of such annual license fee per quarter or any fractional part thereof.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 10 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'All new licenses to operate motor vehicles issued after December 31, 1958 shall expire at midnight on the license holder's second birthday next following the date of issuance of said license. The fee for such license shall be \$\frac{\$\pi}{2}\$5.'
