STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Coercive Practices in Retail Sale and Distribution of Gasoline.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 130, § 37, additional. Chapter 130 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 37, to read as follows:

'Coercive Practices in the Retail Sale and Distribution of Gasoline.

Sec. 37. Coercive practices in the retail sale and distribution of gasoline. No wholesaler, distributor, jobber, supplier or other person engaged in the wholesale distribution of gasoline and petroleum products shall in any way, directly or indirectly, interfere with, restrain or coerce any retail dealer in motor fuel in respect to the price at which such retail dealer shall sell at retail such gasoline or petroleum products.'
