STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Default under Trustee Process.

Be it cnacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 114, § 28. Section 28 of chapter 114 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 28. Trustee not appearing defaulted. When a person summoned as trustee neglects to appear and answer to the suit, he shall be defaulted and adjudged trustee as alleged but not in excess of the amount of the goods, effects or credits in his hands or possession as trustee of the principal defendant.'
