AN ACT Limiting Appearances as Counsel Before State Tax Assessor to Attorneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 155, § 1-A, additional. Chapter 155 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1-A, to read as follows:

‘Appearances as Counsel

Sec. 1-A. Limited to attorneys. No person, unless duly admitted to the general practice of law in this State shall appear as counsel before the State Tax Assessor in any matter or proceeding under this chapter.’
