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AN ACT Exempting Certain Salesmen from the Minimum Wage Law.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 30, § 132-B, sub-§ III, ¶ J, additional.** Subsection III of section 132-B of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the public laws of 1959, is amended by adding a new paragraph J, to read as follows:

**'J. Any individual whose earnings are derived in whole or in part from commissions; and who is not required by his employer to spend over 50% of his working hours at the employer's place of employment.'**
