STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Exit Facilities in Nursing Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 97, § 48-A, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 48-A of chapter 97 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 163 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'I. Building exits code followed. The regulations shall conform as nearly as practicable with the Building Exits Code as adopted and amended by the National Fire Protection Association. Such regulations shall apply to nursing homes having one or more patients, other than relatives of the owner or owners.'
