AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Liquor License for Sale to Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 56, sub-§ II-A, additional. Section 56 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 218 of the public laws of 1959 and amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection II-A, to read as follows:

'II-A. Sales to minors. The Hearing Examiner shall suspend the license for making sales to persons under age as prohibited by law, 15 days for the first offense and 30 days for any subsequent offense.'
