STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Credit for Military Service Under State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 3, sub-§ VI, amended. Subsection VI of section 3 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, and as amended by chapter 26 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, as follows:

'Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, credit toward retirement shall be allowed for military service as provided herein to teachers and state employees even though not employed in Maine prior to entering such military service, provided such persons are employed in Maine as teachers or state employees following their military service and provided they are employed in either capacity for at least 10 years thereafter in Maine.'
