**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Knox County and
Judge of Rockland Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Knox County is amended to read as follows:

'Knox County: County commissioners, \$1,000; clerk of courts, ~~\$3,340~~ \$3,500; county attorney, \$2,800; treasurer, \$1,000; sheriff, ~~\$3,600~~ \$4,000; register of deeds, ~~\$3,000~~ \$3,400; judge of probate, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,700; register of probate, ~~\$2,100~~ \$2,600; Rockland municipal court judge, ~~\$2,400~~ \$3,700; ~~recorder~~ **associate judge**, \$2,000.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1961.
