STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Number Plates for Antique Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 5th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

'The number plates furnished for antique motor vehicles shall have a red background with white letters. The design shall be as follows:

Top line, the word "MAINE," with place for date tab as regular number plate. Right, centered up and down, silhouette of early Stanley Steamer, built in 1897 by Maine natives, F. O. and F. E. Stanley.

Bottom line, the words "MAINE OBSOLETE AUTOMOBILE," from the title of the state's original Antique Auto Club.'
