## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating the Digging of Clams in Wells, York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 154, Chapter A, § 4, sub-§ III, repealed and replaced. Subsection III, including paragraphs A and B, of section 4 of Chapter A of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'III. License required to dig or take clams in Wells. No person shall, in the Town of Wells in the County of York, dig or take clams unless license has been granted to him by the municipal officers of said town, who are authorized to grant and issue such licenses and fix the fee therefor.'
