STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Capital Outlays by School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 111-K, amended. Section 111-K of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1-B of chapter 364 and as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by section 9 of chapter 353 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by adding a new sentence to read as follows:

'The board of school directors of a School Administrative District shall not issue bonds or notes for capital outlay purposes, nor propose the issuance of bonds or notes for capital outlay purposes for approval by the qualified voters of the district, until 18 months has elapsed since the School District Commission issued its certificate of organization to such School Administrative District.'
