IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Clarifying Withdrawals from School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 111-P, amended. The last sentence of section 111-P of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1-B of chapter 364 and repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

It is declared to be the policy of the Legislature not to authorize such withdrawal while such School Administrative District shall be indebted upon bonds or notes issued for capital outlay purposes by the school directors pursuant to approval thereof in a district meeting of such School Administrative District.'
