AN ACT Relating to Withdrawals from School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 111-P, amended. Section 111-P of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1-B of chapter 364 and as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘After the residents of a participating municipality have so indicated their desire to withdraw, the clerk thereof shall forthwith give written notice of the same to the clerks of all other participating municipalities in such School Administrative District. Within 60 days after the receipt of such written notice by the clerk, each of the other participating municipalities at a regular or special town meeting or city election shall vote on the 2 questions of whether the municipality favors the dissolution of the School Administrative District and whether, in the event withdrawal of one municipality is authorized, the municipality favors the continued operation of a School Administrative District by the remaining municipalities. The function of all votes by participating municipalities pursuant to this section shall be advisory to the Legislature.’
