STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Notice in Disputed Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 89, amended. Section 89 of chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 26 of chapter 204 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by adding after the first sentence the following sentence:

'The requirement of notice under this section shall be deemed complied with if the notice is sent by certified or registered mail addressed to the city or town in the elective district in which said candidate being notified is resident, even if no United States post office is there maintained.'
