COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 396, L. D. 1343, Bill - "An Act
Creating an Administrative Code for State of Maine."

Amend said Bill by adding in Sec. 1, I after "F. Children's
homes." the following underlined paragraph: 'G. Control of ionizing
radiation.'

Further amend said Bill by adding the following after the
first paragraph of Sec. 12: 'The Hearing Officer shall have no power
or authority under this or any other section of this Administrative
Code to hear or in any way determine the competence or qualifications
of any person applying to an agency for a license to engage in a
profession or business.'
