SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 417, L. D. 1356, Bill, "An Act Relating to Outdoor Advertising on the Interstate System."

Amend said Bill by striking out subsection III of section 3 thereof and inserting in its place a new subsection III to read as follows:

"III. Areas adjacent to Interstate System. Advertising signs or advertising structures or devices in areas adjacent to segments of the Interstate System which traverse commercial or industrial zones legally designated as such by incorporated municipalities. Following such designation the Commission shall regulate outdoor advertising thereon under the provisions of sections 137 to 146.
