AN ACT Including Piers and Terminals in Maine Industrial Building Authority Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38-B, § 5, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 5 of chapter 38-B of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 421 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows :

‘III. “Industrial project” shall mean any building or other real estate improvement and, if a part thereof, the land upon which they may be located, and all real properties deemed necessary to their use by any industry for the manufacturing, processing or assembling of raw materials or manufactured products, and shall mean any pier and terminal.’
