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AN ACT Relating to Regulation of Fishing by Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 5, repealed.** Section 5 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed.

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 9, repealed and replaced.** Section 9 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 9. Rules and regulations. All local regulations relating to inland fishing will be promulgated by rule and regulation of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, but nothing herein shall be construed to limit the Legislature from enacting general laws to regulate fishing. The advisory council on fish and game is designated as a board of appeals to hear cases of hardship caused by such rules and regulations of the commissioner.’
