STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Dogs Injuring or Killing Wild Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 98, amended. Section 98 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'If any dog, at any time, shall maim, injure or destroy any wild animal protected by law, the owner thereof shall be fined the same amount which the statutes impose upon persons for killing the same animal in closed season. Any dog apprehended in such act shall be destroyed forthwith.'
