STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Clerks of Courts For Entry of Action and Motion.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 99, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 99 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Entry of an action, or entering up and recording the judgment, whether on a verdict, demurrer, nonsuit or default, \$1 \$5.

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 99, amended. Section 99 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 190 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by adding a new paragraph after the 4th paragraph to read as follows:

'Entry of a motion, \$1.'
