STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Requiring Parking Meters to Indicate Elapsed Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 90-A, § 3, sub-§ II, ¶ D, sub-¶ 2, additional. Paragraph D of subsection II of section 3 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subparagraph 2, to read as follows:
 - '2. Each parking meter which may be installed, or any similar device used for metering parking on any public way or public parking area for which a charge is made, shall visibly register the number of minutes elapsed after the deposit of the user's coin.'
