STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Industrial Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 31, § 29, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 29 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 9 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The chairman (Industrial Accident Commission) shall receive a salary of \$10,000 \$11,500 per year, and the other commissioners a salary of \$9,000 \$10,500 each per year.'

(There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this section.)

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
