AN ACT Relating to Fee for Registration of Farm Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ III, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection III of section 16 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The minimum fee shall never be less than \$2. ~~Provided, however, that the~~ **The** maximum fee for all **farm** trailers, whether semi-trailers or four-wheeled type, equipped with pneumatic tires ~~and drawn at all times exclusively by farm tractors~~, shall be \$2 for each trailer when the said trailers are used and and to be used by farmers for the sole and exclusive purpose of transporting their own farm products, crops, fertilizers and farm tools and utensils and subject to the further conditions and limitations that

- A.** no such load so transported shall at any time exceed 4 tons;
- B.** no such load shall be transported a distance greater than 20 miles from the point of origin to the point of destination; and
- C.** no such load shall be transported on the public highways of this State at a speed in excess of 15 miles an hour.'
