STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Time Limitations for Filing Petitions Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 33, amended. The last sentence of section 33 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 325 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'Want of proper notice or delay in filing claim will not bar the employee, if it is found by the commission that the insurer, insured or agent had knowledge of the injury or was not prejudiced thereby.'
