**AN ACT Designating Monday for Observance of Memorial Day.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 107, § 55, amended.** Section 55 of chapter 107 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 3 of chapter 230 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

**‘Whenever Memorial Day falls on a day other than Monday, the legal holiday for such date shall be observed on the last Monday in May.’**

**Sec. 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect whenever after January 1, 1963 the Governor shall determine and by proclamation declare that the majority of the following states, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island and Connecticut shall have, each by law, designated the last Monday in May for the observance of Memorial Day.
