## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Exits in Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 97, § 48-A, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 48-A of chapter 97 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 163 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

**'I. Building exits code followed.** The regulation shall conform as nearly as practicable with the Building Exits Code as adopted and amended by the National Fire Protection Association. A building shall be deemed to be in compliance with such rules and regulations if the building is otherwise protected by automatic sprinklers, fire alarm system or fire resistant walls enclosing its heating system or a combination thereof.'
