SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1013, L. D. 1414, Bill, "An Act Classifying Certain Waters in Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end a new section to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Application. The classifications set forth in sections 1 and 2 shall become effective on October 1, 1961. A municipality, sewer district, person, firm, corporation, the State or any subdivision thereof, or other legal entity shall not be deemed to be in violation of the Revised Statutes, chapter 79, section 4 at any time or times prior to October 1, 1973, with respect to any of said classifications if by such time or times he or it, with regard to a project designed to achieve compliance with the applicable classification, shall have completed all of the steps required to be then completed by the following schedule:

I. Preliminary plans and engineers' estimates shall be completed and submitted to the Water Improvement Commission on or before October 1, 1963.

II. Arrangements for administration and financing shall be completed on or before October 1, 1967. This period, in the case of municipalities, shall encompass all financing including obtaining of state and federal grants.

III. Detailed engineering and final plan formulation shall be completed on or before October 1, 1968.

IV. Review of final plans with the Water Improvement Commission shall be completed and construction started on or before October 1, 1969.

V. Construction shall be completed on or before October 1, 1973.'
