**AN ACT Classifying Certain Waters in Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 15, amended.** Section 15 of chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new caption "Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed" to follow subsection XIII under the caption "Mousam River Basin and Adjacent Coastal Area," to read as follows:

**'Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed.**

**I. Waters not previously classified of the main stem and direct and indirect tributaries of the Salmon Falls and Piscataqua Rivers, within the State of Maine, above tidewater—Class B-1.'**

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 15, amended.** Section 15 of chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new caption "Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed" to follow subsection XLIV under the caption "Tidal Waters, York County," to read as follows:

**'Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Watershed.**

**I. Tidal waters not previously classified on the Salmon Falls-Piscataqua River Estuary bordering the State of Maine between the head of tide on the Salmon Fall-Piscataqua River and Sister's Point on Gerrish Island in Kittery—Class B-1.'**
