STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Limiting Use of Transient Rental Revenues to Recreational Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 15, amended. The last paragraph of section 15 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The **Tax** Assessor shall pay over all receipts collected to the Treasurer of State daily and such receipts shall be credited to the General Fund, except that receipts from the transient rental tax shall be placed in a separate account to be used for the purpose of recreational advertising as provided by the Legislature.'
