AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Androscoggin County Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the salaries of the following county officials of Androscoggin County, are amended to read as follows:

'County commissioners, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,200; chairman, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,800; clerk of courts, ~~\$4,000~~ \$6,200; county attorney, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500; assistant county attorney, ~~\$3,200~~ \$3,500; county treasurer, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500; sheriff, ~~\$4,750~~ \$5,250; register of deeds, ~~\$4,600~~ \$5,000; judge of probate, ~~\$4,400~~ \$5,000; register of probate, ~~\$3,600~~ \$4,000.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$1,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney and salary of the assistant county attorney of Androscoggin County. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1961.
