STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Specially Designed Motor Vehicle Number Plates for Representatives of Indian Tribes at the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 18, amended. The first sentence of the last paragraph of section 18 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 60 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State shall, upon application therefor by Maine members of the United States Senate, Maine members of the United States House of Representatives, members of the Executive Council, members of the Legislature, **Representatives of the Indian Tribes at the Legislature**, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House, issue one pair of specially designed number plates and a certificate of registration for one designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by each of the officials named ~~herein~~ herein.'
