STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Self-Propelled Wheelchairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting as the next to last paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State on application shall issue, without the payment of any fee, a registration certificate and registration plates for a self-propelled wheel-chair owned and operated by any invalid person when such application is accompanied by the certification of at least 2 physicans as to such person's physical incapacity.'
