STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Guardians of Persons Receiving Old Age
Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 285, amended. Section 285 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Pendency of petition in a probate court of this State for the appointment of a guardian of a recipient of assistance shall not serve to disqualify or suspend the right of the recipient to receive such assistance, which shall not be discontinued or suspended by reason thereof.'
