IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Paraplegics to Hunt from Stationary Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 78, amended. Section 78 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to paraplegics hunting from stationary motor vehicles.'
