HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1085, L. D. 1495, Resolve, in Favor
of Stanley Megquier of Orient.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the title, the following
emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves do not become
effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the damages to the property, which is the subject
matter of this resolve, and which were created by the construction
of U. S. highway #1 should be repaired as soon as possible so that
the occupant may enjoy his home in 1961; and

Whereas, the necessary repairs should be undertaken as soon as
possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end, before the
statement of facts, the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
