SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S. P. 512, L. D. 1529, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution Exempting Certain Industrial
Property from Taxation.

Amend said Resolve in that part designated "Sec. 8." by
striking out, in the 5th line, the underlined words "or relocating"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined punctuation and words
', relocating or being rebuilt'

Further amend said Resolve in that part designated "Sec. 8."
by striking out, in the 7th line, the underlined words "or relocation"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined punctuation and words
', relocation or replacement within the municipality following the
destruction of such property by fire or storm'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 13th
line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'exceed 5 years from the time of such location or relocation and the
municipality may require a bond from the industry for faithful
performance of any contract made between the municipality and the
industry relative to the nonassessment of such taxes; but'
